The 6th Siam Physics Congress (SPC2011) will be held at the Ambassador City Jomtien Hotel, Pattaya, Chonburi during 23-26 March 2011. The Siam Physics Congress was initiated in 2006 by the Thai Physics Society (TPS). The aim of the congress is to bring together national and international physicists, physics teachers, technologists, young scientists as well as those who are interested in physics from a variety of fields (covering both basic and applied physics research) in order to give them an opportunity to share and exchange their experiences. The Siam Physics Congress incorporates satellite workshops and annual meetings of the Thai Physics Society, the Thailand Center of Excellence in Physics (ThEP), and the National Astronomical Research Institute of Thailand (NARIT).



Call for Papers. There are two options for papers submitted to SPC2011:

- 1). ABSTRACT ONLY:
 - encouraged for poster presentation
 - should not exceed 400 words
- 2). FULL PAPER (CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS):
 - encouraged for either a poster or an oral presentation
 - should not exceed 4 pages
 - all accepted full papers will be published in the conference proceedings distributed at the conference

All submission must be written in English. All accepted papers will be published in the Book of Abstract distributed at the conference. At least one author of each accepted paper must register for the conference.

THAI JOURNAL OF PHYSICS SERIES 6: All authors are invited to submit full papers for publication in a peer-reviewed special issue of Thai Journal of Physics Series 6. As a result of the peer review, there is a possibility that your paper may need to be revised.
